Invitation to the 2019 Kanga Cup in Canberra, Australia

To whom it may concern,

On behalf of the Kanga Cup Organising Committee (KCOC) and Capital Football, I take great pleasure in warmly inviting any teams from Beijing to attend the 2019 McDonald's Kanga Cup, to be held from 7-12th July in Canberra.

The McDonald's Kanga Cup is the largest international youth football tournament in the southern hemisphere. The event, now in its 29th year, has been held in Canberra since 1992. The McDonald's Kanga Cup is open to male and female players aged U9 to U18 years, and in 2018 the event hosted over 350 teams made up of 7000+ participants across 6 days of football.

The McDonald's Kanga Cup has enjoyed a great relationship with international teams in the past, having had representatives from nations such as Philippines, Indonesia, South Africa, China, Republic of Korea and New Zealand. The Kanga Cup and Capital Football are looking at further expanding its relationship with the Asian Football community and are very excited at the prospect of your team attending.

Entry into the McDonald's Kanga Cup is only available to affiliated clubs of a member of an International Football Association affiliated to FIFA. All teams must provide a letter of sanction from their National Football Association (or school, or academy) with their documentation in order to fulfil the protocols involved in competing with another part of the International Football Family. International teams must also organise and provide proof of their own travel visas (for players and officials), and have proof of travel insurance to cover personal accident or injury.

The Kanga Cup is a celebration of culture, football, friendship and fun for the youth of the world. We would love to welcome teams from Beijing to participate in the event.
